What is the RAW?

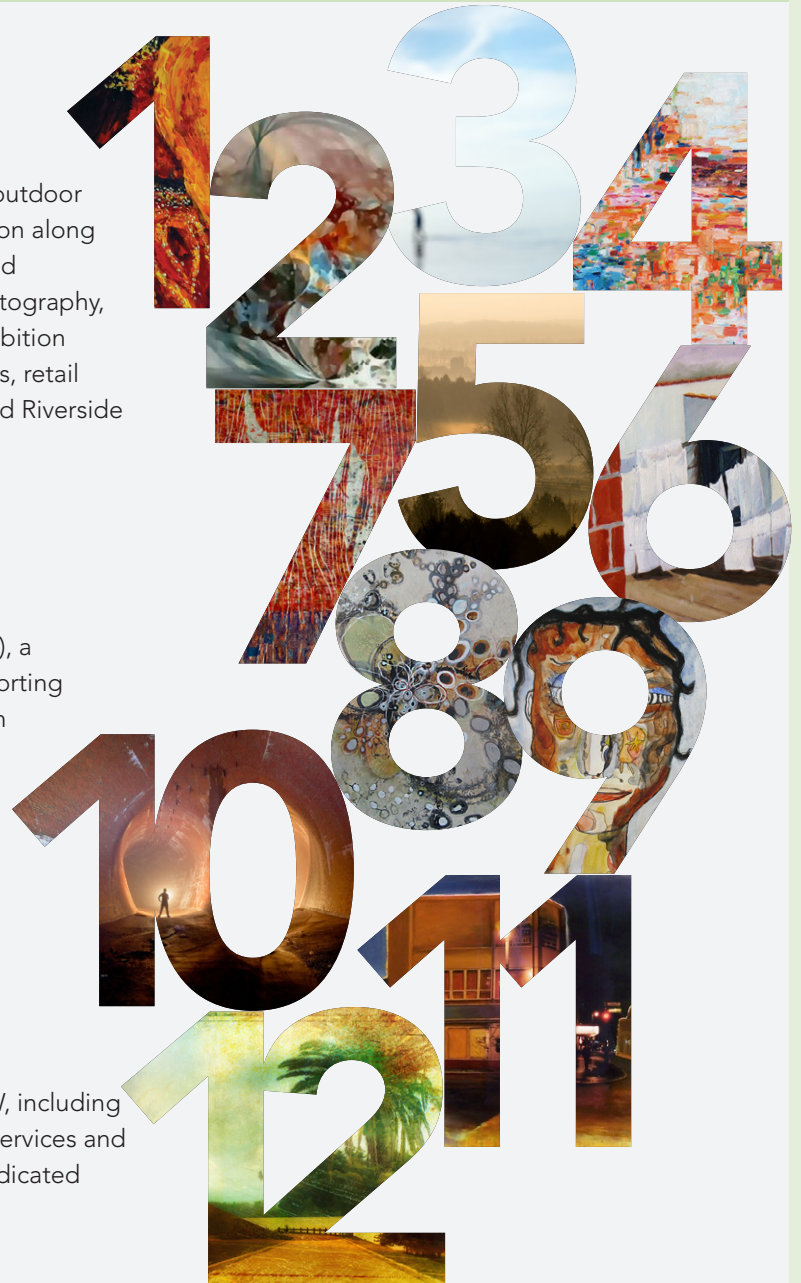
For 12 year, the Riverdale Art Walk has launched Toronto's outdoor art exhibition season with its two-day juried fine art exhibition along Queen Street East, featuring both emerging and established Canadian artists showcasing original works in painting, photography, drawing, new media, sculpture, and mixed media. This exhibition annually draws over 10,000 people to artist studios, galleries, retail spaces, and Jimmie Simpson Park in the south Riverdale and Riverside neighbourhoods of Toronto.

Who presents the RAW?

The RAW is presented annually by the Artists' Network (AN), a non-profit, membership-based initiative dedicated to supporting professional visual artists in their business practice. Through the RAW, the Little Art Show, Hang Man Gallery shows and other events, the AN strives to offer artists an affordable opportunity to exhibit, promote and sell their work, grow an educated and eager collector base and establish South Riverdale and Riverside as an arts destination.
